

CYP Raspberry Pi project.

What is a Raspberry Pi? It's a tiny computer, cheap enough that young people can experiment with programming it themselves, and through our project can develop coding skills to produce simple games, control models and much more.

We'll be running some taster sessions between 5pm and 7pm on alternate Tuesdays (13th March, 27th March and so on if demand continues) Cost will be £1.50 per session, and initially equipment will be available to borrow. Keen new programmers may need to buy themselves an inexpensive chip to store their work, and even a Pi of their own to work on at home, but no need to do so immediately. Our tutor Trevor will advise you.
